From the Commodore

March already - not much longer until the start of the sailing season. By the time this is published, the Racing committee and Social committees will have met and roughed out the racing and social schedules for the year. Those schedules will be included in the Membership Handbook. Check the BOG minutes for more information about this year's handbooks.

Sand beach - The board decided to stop plans for testing a sand beach in front of the shelter house. Practicality and cost of the total project were the primary drivers. The board is still exploring ways to improving the appearance of that shoreline by controlling plant growth or by other means.

Currently the lake is slightly less than four feet low. Hopefully spring rains will help fill it back up. Until the lake level rises, the public ramp may have to be utilized for early spring launches. We may also need a few volunteers to help reset anchors on the dinghy dock when the lake rises – we'll see.

I met with a couple of board members at the lake last week and was reminded of the importance of generally observing things and reporting something of concern. Last month Gene Nold advised me the field south of the dry storage area was extremely dry and appeared to be a greater fire hazard than normal even though the normal firebreak had been mowed. John McCabe contacted David Reynolds who completed the mowing. When you're at the lake during the off season, please take a look around and report anything that doesn't seem right. Please contact any board member, appropriate liaison/committee chair, or boat owner.





LEARN TO SAIL 2018

2018 Summer STEP Program Dates The club's STEP program will host various "learn to sail" clinics and camps this summer for both adults and youth.

The two adult sessions will solely focus on keelboat instruction. The main topics covered in the class will include sailing instruction on the water, boat maintenance, what to look for when purchasing a boat, boat safety and wind/weather conditions. Instruction will be on a Catalina 22 and a Sonar. The dates and times are as follows:

Session One: May 18th – 21st

Session Two: May $24^{th} - 27^{th}$.

Thursday and Friday 6:00pm to sunset and Saturday and Sunday 9:00am to 1:00pm.

The youth program will have three sessions to accommodate sailors coming to the program with varying degrees of sailing experience. They are as follows:

Session One for the Beginning Sailor: June 4th, 5th, 7th & 8th. This session is for the sailor new to sailing or with very little experience. Instruction will be on Prams, Optis and Sabots. For ages 8-11.

Session Two for the Intermediate Sailor: June 11th, 12th, 14th 15th, 18th 19th 21st, 22nd This session is for the returning sailor that has some experience sailing or is a repeat camper. Instruction will be on Catalina 14.2's. For ages 12 and up.

Session One and Two will be from 10:00am to 4:00pm

Session Three for the Advanced Sailor: July 9th, 10th 11th & 12th. This session requires approval from the instructor and is for the advanced sailor. Instruction will be on lasers or the equivalent. This is a fast paced, intense course focused on racing strategies, team racing, match racing and sail trim. Sailors will compete in the club's Wednesday night racing program during the week of the camp. This session may be taken by youth and adults. There are a limited number of club lasers, it is recommended that sailors bring their own boat.

Session Three will be from 4:00pm to sunset.

WVSC Members:


