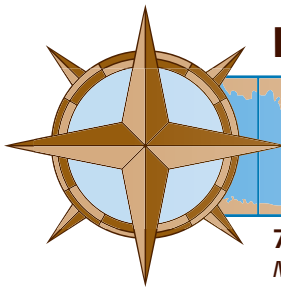

### 6. New Website development

- The previous website developer had to back out of this effort due to time constraints. Public Relations Committee will be seeking new person to develop WVSC website. Dave Lieker is to contact potential website developer on this.

### 7. Action items from prior meetings:

- Flotation:** Purchased flotation was installed by 3rd party; will continue to explore further flotation options/solutions for dock fingers with metal substructures close to/in the water
- Increased electric bills during off-season:** Due to the 300% increase in winter electrical bills, WVSC will be implementing an additional \$100 fee per member using a bubbler, and/or an additional \$100 fee for the use of space heaters in boats, during the winter. Notice will be sent to all members indicating that the \$100 fee will be assessed for electrical usage from January 1 – March 31, 2015.

Electrical usage has also increased in the summer, due to A/Cs used in boats. A \$100 fee will be assessed for boats using air conditioning, on the annual slip rental agreement.

- Boat Insurance:** All members with a boat will be required to carry and provide proof of \$100,000 liability insurance on their boat. This information will also be required on the annual membership renewal.
- STEP fundraising opportunities:** Randy Malcolm is to form a committee to explore future STEP fundraising opportunities.
- By Law Reviews:** Zack Kissack is to form a committee to define the limitations of proxies in the by-laws, article V.
- Kubick Boat:** Volunteers will assist in removing this boat from WVSC property.
- Activity Center Floor:** The activity center floor is to be repainted by 4/15/15.
- ADA Compliance:** The new French door is to be installed, and Security key pad lowered by 4/15/15.
- AUP Audit:** John Aschbrenner is to work with the Finance Committee on initiating this audit. The new rules on Finance Internal Controls need to be added to the rules and regulations.
- Windword editor:** Kim Oblak is resigning as editor of the Windword, in order to support Brad's increased responsibility as Treasurer. A new editor needs to be found, as soon as possible.

### 8. Members Concerns:

- Some members could not read the emailed Windword. Public Relations Committee is to check into the problem.
- Paul Schye brought forth concerns on events that happened during the annual meeting, claiming the unethical behavior of members. Much discussion followed. The Commodore is to follow up on this issue.
