Their detailed planning and tremendous effort directly led to a successful New Orleans style dinner that everyone enjoyed. 5. **Liaison reports.** Kathy Malcom went through the end of year planned expenditures and 2018 budget requests with each committee’s board liaison. Please submit any outstanding receipts you may have in order to get it on the books prior to the end of our fiscal year. Overall, the Club is financially healthy, and as Club, we’ve done a solid job of staying within our budget in 2017. **One issue that surfaced during the review was the increased cost of electricity due to seasonal usage from bubblers, heaters, and air conditioners. We’ll review actual cost impacts, the previous Club plan and look for a fair way to address the situation.**

Activities Center	Steve reported no new issues with the Clubhouse this month.
Building and Grounds	Paul reported that the parking lot re-surfacing plans are taking shape – more to follow on the timing.
Powerboat	Blaine reported the power boat cover purchase is moving along, funded by the 2016 “Funraiser” contributions and Powerboat and Racing committee budgets.
Dry-Storage	From Paul, plans are underway to re-zone a limited number of dry storage spots to permit wider spots (15 ft) for our larger boats. Goal is to preserve good access for trailers for all our members.
Finance	Paul submitted the monthly budget reports for August. All slip fees are paid in full.
Harbor	Paul stated we are still pursuing floatation improvements for the docks this year.
Racing Activities	Blaine reported we raced in very light air and had one cancellation over the past 2 weeks. Still racing on Saturdays through Oct, come on out if you’d like to race.
STEP	Deann – look for an opportunity to help out this fall. Date will be set to help pull the STEP boats out of the water and move to dry storage area. Date TBD.
