SLIP CORNERS

At the Board Meeting of June 14, 1994 approval was granted for slip lessees to fill in slip corners, at their own expense, under the following conditions:

- 1. Design and workmanship shall conform to the 10' and 12' examples located in slips B-8 and B-16 (Cooper and Plehal).
 - a. All lumber to be 2" x 6", CCA Treated yellow pine, #2 or better.
 - b. All lumber shall be new and no warped or twisted boards permitted.
 - All fastners shall be galvanized or clad steel deck screws. (you will need 2", 2.5' and 3' screws)
 - d. All miter joints shall be cut at 45 degrees.
 - e. The 2" x 6" deck boards must be spaced at least 3/8" apart to conform to the appearance of the existing docks.
- 2. Once in place, slip corners shall become the property of WVSC and not be removed should the lessee change slips.
- 3. See diagrams below for construction details.
- 4. If you are not a reasonably accomplished carpenter, please get help! The object is to make these additions pleasing in appearance. Call Jerry Cooper or Gene Plehal if you have questions.
