






































Click on the graph at right to view current lake level data.

Troy expressed thanks to members attending. All volunteers here to keep the organization and are greatly appreciated.

November 16 BOG Meeting Minutes Approval

Minutes of the 16 November BOG meeting were presented. Julie Barth moved to accept the minutes. Troy Oberly seconded. A correction for Sailing Activities; sentence to be corrected to Sailing Activities (was "Security"). The minutes were approved as updated

Membership Concerns -

Group noted that the \$20 Christmas Party cost included the round of champagne.

Doors Open at 5:30. Begins at 6:00; we will eat at 6:30 - 7:00 We need to be Out at 9:00.

Dana Herring and Tim Miller made a request to pick up (and use) old discarded hydro-lift floats (in the Dry Storage). Discussion indicates we can allow Dana to make first bid. We will need place notice of the auction in the Windword We can allow 2 weeks for bidding. These are fiberglass (boat lifting) floats. We don't yet have an opening bid. Dana is rebuilding his lift. Doug send info to Tedd. Julie will send a text. Stuart will chair the escalating bidding.

Trailer beside the dump is Brant Dumford's. We are checking for currency of yard fees.

New Business -

Requesting BOG approval for Preston Brammert's Dock Box. Noted that Preston must follow the guidelines for this Installation.

The specifications are provided on the wall in clubhouse. Also on the web-site, under regulations.

Preston Brammer moved approval. Julie Barth seconded. The motion was approved..

Mike Shepperd reviewing members handbook. Last published in 2019. Do we have obligation to update this? Will check with Charlier Volk to see its status.

[Secretary is recording discussions related to the proposed addition of a security system.]

Troy Oberly will use commodore talk time to discuss this with the attendees (at the Christmas Dinner)..

Noted: "We have responsibility to protect members boats, assets, and safety". Will also talk about concerns about our trajectory and intent. This intent is to move toward an on-line vote, or set a specific meeting to receive membership votes. During the January BOG meeting we will receive concerns from any and every member wishing to speak, During the February BOG meeting will receive votes from the membership.

Noted: "There is a need for understanding of the number of cameras proposed, and areas that are proposed to be "watched".

These currently envisioned as: Docks, gangway, possibly dry storage areas, not inside the clubhouse. We have intent to place signage to indicate video surveillance is present. Our goal is to secure our common property. Video is under discussion; audio has not been vetted totally. The current alarm system would be retained.

Options of a WiFi system (full bandwidth) <u>may</u> allow individual boat owners to place cameras.

There is fair amount if interest in StarLink (with much broader bandwidth), and also Velocity (a local company, much less bandwidth).

Julie presents a good idea to first check for members' interes. After the February vote we can present additional options including "selling" additional bandwidth. The first presentation is for Clubhouse security usage of Wifi.

Stuart provided suggestion that we can use the electronic equipment at the station to field a Zoom meeting if desired; required equipment is present.

Question: "Is the Clubhouse movement (with moving lake levels) an issue with Velocity? Does anyone know what Perry Marina is doing? Or Shady Creek?" More investigation is needed.

Can we start a sub-committee that will research this more completely? We should wait until after we get a membership vote. Intent is to have "something" operational for the summer season. About February 8th is the date of the meeting for the vote.

Building and Grounds Troy Oberly Mike Shepperd

Driveway sealing has happened. This was the yearly cracks filling. We have been coating every 3-4 years.

Question: "If these have 10 year warranty, why are we coating so often?" We can examine wear, and use this to decide when to update. If we do it ourselves, we could do fractions each year. Could be done early spring (above 50 deg.).

We do have some folks lined up to do mowing. Stuart has a bush-hog.

There is some maintenance needed in the Picnic pavilion.

Discussion with Tedd, Julie has sent 1800 texts. She has an append plan that allows unlimited. A yearly membership saves \$1.89. The texting is working well. Julie will pay for a whole year.
